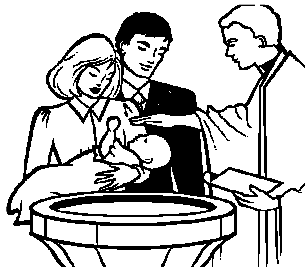

I am writing to ask if you would please be kind enough to help out with the Christian Aid Walk for 2015 which will take place on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> May?

As usual All Saints' are responsible for the starting check point (because we are so good at it!). This year the walk will be starting from Allenbury's Sports Club in Ware. Last year the format was changed to increase the number of participants and raise more money for a very worthwhile charity. There was a different starting time for runners, this was partially successful so the format has been 'tweaked' again to give different starting times for walkers, joggers and runners. We are going to continue with encouraging more online pre-registration, which did help last year, albeit with some teething problems. However the money raised last year was significantly higher at £13,460. This is a substantial amount for Christian Aid and partially due to all your efforts last year, thank you.

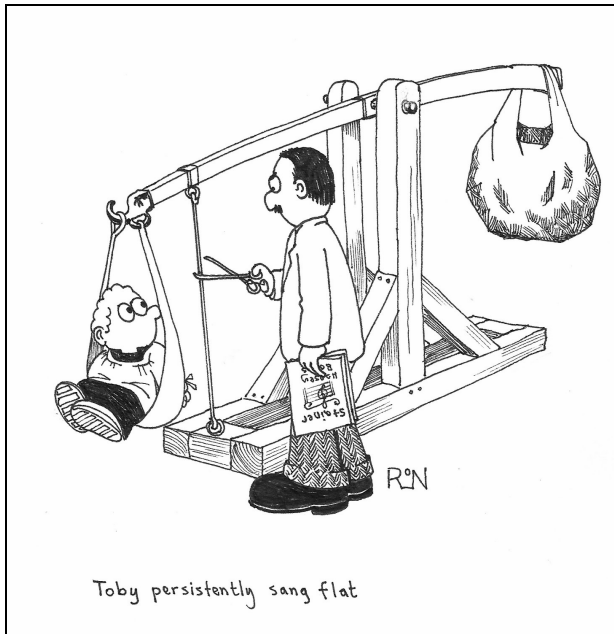

## **Help me raise funds for Alzheimer's research**

This month I am walking the second 60 mile leg of the 146 mile Shakespeare Walk, having completed the first 60 miles from Stratford to Oxford last October. I will complete the walk in the Summer.

Fund raising for Alzheimer's research is very close to my heart as my own dear mother died after early onset of this horrid disease and my sister-in-law has just been diagnosed with it. Many of you will know of someone either in your family or friendship circle who has or is facing a similar diagnosis.

The Alzheimer's Society tells us that currently there are 850,000 people with dementia in the UK and by 2021, dementia

will affect over one million people – about the same as the entire population of Birmingham.

With more funding for their research it could allow them to significantly speed up the process of finding more effective treatments and potentially a cure. This could happen within 5 – 10 years with sufficient funds, so I would be very grateful if you could sign my sponsor form for this very worthwhile charity.

In order to have my walk verified I am collecting signatures as I complete each day's section and anticipate being in a position to collect sponsorship monies by the end of August.
