'Building Hope – Opportunity for All'



Donations received for this Appeal have now reached just over **£55,000** – and money is still coming in. We can celebrate another

inspirational and successful Harvest Appeal – and most welcome, news from our colleagues at Mission Direct of the ongoing work in Uganda, that is being funded by our monies.

They plan to:

- **Build** a brand new dormitory for at least 20 children
- **Renovate** an existing building, making accommodation for another 10 children
- **Create** the infrastructure of ramps and additional facilities needed within the school site

It is agreed, our monies will be spent:

- Building works & materials for the school site – **80%**
- The Chilli Children Project, which supports disabled children at the school – **10%**

And we are pleased to report that work has started:

- Working alongside local people at the school site
