1. Apologies for Absence

2. Approval of the Electoral Roll

- 2.1 Gillian Harman presented the report as follows:
- 2.2 The number on the Electoral Roll for 2011/12 was 197.

- 2.5 This makes this year's total 212, a net increase of 15. Of this total 93 live in the parish and 119 are not resident in the parish. Thus 56% of those on the roll are non resident.
- 2.6 The Electoral Roll was accepted and approved by the meeting.
- 2.7 This was Gillian Harman's last year as Electoral Roll Officer and Revd Jo Loveridge thanked her for her hard work. Jo asked that if anyone would like to take over this role, to please speak to either her or Gillian.
