There are copies of this rota in the vestry and at the west end of the church. **There is no need to tell me.**

Notes on Reading at Parish Communion

All readings are taken from the Common Worship Lectionary. At Communion the congregation will have a copy of the reading printed in front of them, taken from the New Revised Standard Version. Please use this version if possible.

Please introduce your reading as printed on the service sheets with "A reading from N" or "A reading from the letter of Paul to N" and end with "This is the word of the Lord." It is suggested that this formula be used at Morning Prayer, Evensong and Parish Communion.

The Gospel at Communion is introduced by "Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to N", and end with "This is the Gospel of the Lord."

Please be at the lectern ready to start reading your lesson as soon as the previous hymn, psalm, collect, etc., is finished.

Notes on leading Prayers at Parish Communion

There is a high standard of taking prayers at All Saints, but people may find it helpful to bear in mind the following points.

- **Be at the lectern as soon as the Creed is finished.**
- Prayers should last for about five minutes.
- Remember the point of prayers is to pray and not to preach or to tell God what you have read about in your newspaper. He knows already!
- Avoid lengthy introductions.
- Check a few days beforehand who the preacher is that day and ask them what they will be preaching about. This information is available in the blue folder at the back of church. If a preacher's name is not indicated it will be Jo.
- Avoid being controversial. One should pray for the Prime Minister without giving any indication of how you personally vote.
- It is nice to pray for the clergy and their families. It is difficult for them to do it themselves when taking the prayers!
- Try to get to church a few minutes early to look at the pew sheet and note the names of the sick and departed.
