Every community will be touched by the Games – including through the Torch Run that's to pass in easy reach of almost everyone. This means our church can play our part through *More Than Gold's* tested programmes of

outreach, hospitality and service – all undergirded by prayer.

More than Gold's sponsor include the Church of England, the Roman Catholic church, the Methodist Church, the Baptists Union, Churches together etc – a truly broad church.

Outreach – reaching beyond the church walls

Our church is part of a community where people are active and interested in sport. This will

be intensified with the build-up to the 2012 Games, as young and old are

bombarded with Olympic and sports messages through the news, advertising and more.

More Than Gold will help churches make the powerful link between sports and faith both before and during the Games.

The vast possibilities include –

- Children's Holiday Clubs on an Olympic theme
- Sports clinics for youth and children
- Community festivals, with churches working together to host a local Olympic party
- Guest events, including a pub-style sports quiz

These approaches – and more – offer each church a way to do what's appropriate to their own situation and resources. With *More Than Gold* on hand with help and experience.

Hospitality – a generous welcome in Jesus' name

Genuine faith is always expressed through generous and welcoming hospitality. *More Than Gold's* aim is for the 2012 Games to be renowned for the level of hospitality offered to overseas visitors by the UK's Christians.

Through the *More Than Gold* hospitality programme, churches and their members can serve the athletes' families and the hundreds of thousands of visitors coming for the Games.

The opportunities include –

- Hosting the families of Games athletes – providing a bed and practical help for those who would otherwise miss seeing their relatives take part
- Hosting members of international mission teams coming to share their faith with visitors and serve churches in their outreach
- Serving at *More Than Gold* Hospitality Centres, which will show practical care to visitors including giving away a million cups of water. There is something every church can do to offer a welcome in Jesus' name.

Service – putting the love of Christ into action

The 2012 Games present a magnificent opportunity for churches and their members to show how the love of Christ leads to serving others. And an army of dedicated volunteers is vital if *More Than Gold's* extensive programme is to be delivered.

There is something everyone can do to serve – young and not-so-young. Some will have specialist skills and others will be just willing to muck in.

Much needed are those who will serve as –

- Part-time and full-time volunteers helping with our conferences and training programme as office support, administrators, data enterers, runners and humpers and more
- On teams to welcome and serve the official Olympic Torch Run through UK cities

Another way is to volunteer directly with LOCOG, the Games organisers, in one of their many roles.

By far the best way for a church to evaluate the opportunities of *More Than Gold* is to appoint their own church representative – a Gold Champion.

The role of a Gold Champion is –

- To be the channel for information from *More Than Gold* to their church
- To link with other Gold Champions in their area to share ideas, plans and opportunities

Gold Champions receive their own dedicated eNewsupdate and invitations to special briefings.

Having a Gold Champion also gives a church access to all the *More Than Gold* communication resources
