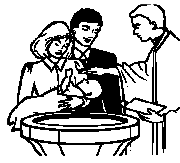

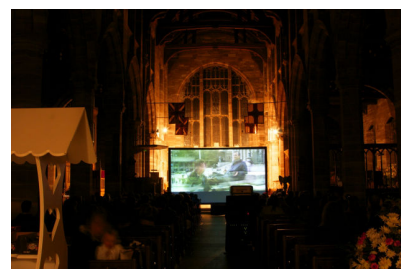
## Final parade and laying up of the HRA Standard
