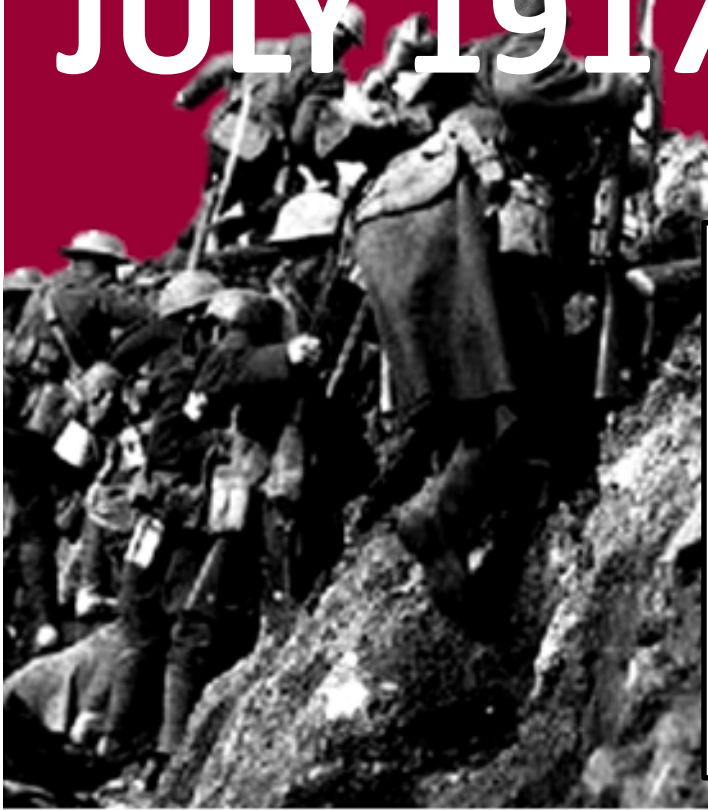

## Remembering WWI and the Hertfordshire Regiment



In a brave attempt to break the German 'Langemarck Line', on just one day, 31 July 1917, the Hertfordshire Regiment lost 479 of their 620 men. They were killed, gravely injured or captured in the battle which lasted only two hours, from 8.00 to 10.00am just outside the small village of St Julien.
