Take some leaves from the garden and dry them. Then heat them in small amount of olive oil in a frying pan. Watch and stir the leaves until they are dark brown, going black.

Remove the leaves and allow to cool, then either with a mortar or a sieve grind the leaves, add olive oil and proceed as above. Do not worry if the ash is not smooth and is bitty.

In *Living His Story*, Hannah Steele uncovers liberating and practical ways of sharing the gospel story afresh. We will be meeting on Zoom to share our thoughts and discuss the week's readings each Tuesday evening at 7:30, for the six weeks of Lent, starting on February 23<sup>rd</sup>.
