Dear Friends,

This week we reflect on how Jesus says to his disciples "Peace be with you". It's a phrase so often used in our services that we may not always stop to think about this peace. What does it mean, how are we given this peace and what difference does this make to the way we live our lives?

I imagine that we respond in the same way as Jesus' disciples reacted as it says in Luke's Gospel, with a mixture of fear, joy, disbelieving and wondering. Jesus has to open their minds to the true meaning of the Scriptures, to assure them that this is not something too good to be true or - even worse - some bizarre superstition but a lasting, life-giving reality of God's eternal love and salvation.

During this third Lockdown, our lives may well have felt far from peaceful, our emotions often churning up because of fear, loss and isolation and as the restrictions begin to ease I hope that we can listen out for those words of peace, reflect on their deep meaning and live out this peace in our daily lives.

## **Annual meetings**

These will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> April by Zoom. If anyone is unable to join us by computer, tablet, smart phone or telephone, please speak to Jo.

The Diocese ran some training on Annual Meetings earlier this year covering both what the new '2020 Church Representation Rules' require and also how to hold them safely during the pandemic.

We will be holding two meetings:

A 'Meeting of Parishioners' at 11.00, solely to choose two Churchwardens. This is open to "the persons whose names are entered on the church electoral roll of the parish; and the persons resident in the parish whose names

are entered on a register of local government electors by reason of such residence."

The Annual Parochial Church Meeting at 11.05 Open to those on the Electoral Roll of the Parish. In accordance with the guidance from the Diocese this meeting will cover the following:

- a report on the changes to the Electoral Roll since the last Annual Meeting.
- An annual report on the proceedings of the PCC and the activities of the parish generally,
- the financial statements of the PCC for the year ending on the 31 December preceding the meeting,
- the annual Fabric Report under section 50 of the Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction and Care of Churches Measure 2018
- a Report of the proceedings of the Deanery Synod and
- Election of PCC Members.

Please note that other things, e.g. election of sides-people are matters for the PCC and not the APCM and so have not been included.
