

Work Party Report March 2026.

The work party meet at church on the third Saturday of each month between 9 and noon. We carry out a variety of jobs in All Saints Church and St Johns Hall.

Jobs completed in church include: renewing safety tape on the many steps inside All Saints, re-fixing kneeler hooks and loose wood blocks. Checking doors, taps and adjusting toilet locks! re-fixing hearing loop wires and maintaining the Advent Star.

Outside jobs such as: clearing ground, roof and tower gullies and refreshing the wire mesh on downpipes to help trap debris (moss mud and bird parts). Tidying church, hall and memorial garden borders, pruning and planting bulbs. Removing algae from the notice boards and replacing worn rubber seals.

Earlier in 2025 work party members helped to clear from the boiler rooms before work began on installing new boilers. Usable items have recently been put back into the room.

This year, a lot of jobs have been done in the hall including: replacing light bulbs, patching a toilet ceiling following a roof leak, repairing a damaged table, fixing the table trollies so they glide freely and removing unwanted items such as stage curtains. Clearing the perimeter of the hall building and cutting down a large sycamore 'sapling' that was very near to the back of the hall.

In August, we cut the hall and memorial garden hedges and varnished the hall floor.
